Thank you for expressing an interest in volunteering. Your availability, skill set and desire to complete base line SAR courses will determine your level of operational deployment. Our group works in a partnership with the local Police SAR to provide a response to all manner of emergency situations. The group is comprised of 3 main areas of operation.

1. First Response

This group undertakes most of the field-based activities and covers from above the snowline to the beach, including urban and suburban environments. It will involve the use of search techniques such as tracking and navigation, plus potential for occasional deployment to other areas of NZ

There will be an expectation of regular attendance at group meetings and training events.

Individual membership of this team will be reviewed annually.

2. Search Management

This Management Team is responsible for all the planning, logistics and management of all Hawke's Bay Search & Rescue Operations. It includes a number of SAR specialists, many of whom have considerable field and SAR management experience.

3. Operational Support

The operational Support Team consists of a number of volunteers who provide support for both field and non-field activities, and consists of the following –

- Information and Communication Technology (ICT)
- Administration personnel

- Drivers
- Containment teams
- Other volunteers who aspire to join the First Response Team.

Our expectations

As a group our aim is to maintain an engaged and current volunteer membership. To that end, we require all members to achieve and maintain a minimum basic standard of competency and qualification in the below three subjects.

Currently the minimum qualifications for the First Response Team are:

- 1. Outdoor 1st Aid
- 2. SARINZ Search Methods
- 3. SARINZ Track and Clue Awareness

We provide access to full courses and refreshers in these three subjects, plus other SAR skills subjects as training courses become available. A monitoring system will be operating to ensure that our volunteers are current with their qualifications and commitment.
